Whereas, the Finance Department vide communication No. ET/Estt/154/2012 dated 26.03.2013 referred 107 posts of Sub-Inspector (Divisional Cadre Jammu) of the J&K Excise and Commercial Taxes (Subordinate) Services to the J&K Services Selection Board for selection of suitable candidates; and

02- Whereas, the Jammu and Kashmir Services Selection Board vide communication No.SSB/Sel/Secy/014/3549-55 dated 13-05-2014 forwarded selection list of 75 candidates & vide Order No. 99-SSB of 2015 dated 18-02-2015 forwarded selection list of 25 candidates for the posts of Sub-Inspector(Divisional Cadre Jammu); and

03- Whereas, the formal appointment orders were issued in favour of 98 Sub Inspectors by Finance Department vide different Government Orders on the recommendations of the Service Selection Board; and

04- Whereas, as per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court in SWP No. 2086/2013 CMA No. 3072/2013, the Services Selection Board vide communication No. SSB/Secy/Sel/2017/5968-74 dated 06.07.2017 forwarded a select list of 09 candidates for the post of Sub-Inspector (Divisional Cadre Jammu) advertised vide item No. 365 and advertisement notice No. 06 of 2013 indicating therein that recommendation in favour of 01 Sub-Inspector has been kept withheld for want of requisite documents.

05- As recommended by the J&K Services Selection Board, sanction is hereby accorded to the temporary appointment of the below 07 candidates as Sub-Inspector (Divisional Cadre Jammu) in the Pay Band of Rs. 5200-20200 with Grade Pay of Rs. 2400/- in the J&K Excise and Commercial Taxes (Subordinate) Service with immediate effect:-

06- The temporary appointment of the above seven candidates as Sub-Inspectors (Divisional Cadre Jammu) shall be subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- The appointment including pay, service etc shall be governed in terms of J&K by the "New Pension Scheme" as per SHD 400 of 2009 dated 24.12.2009.
- The appointee(s) shall report for duties to the concerned Head of Department as indicated against each within a period of 21 days from the date of issue of this order.
- In case of failure of appointee(s) to join within the stipulated period, his/her appointment shall be deemed to have been cancelled without any further notice.
- The appointee(s) shall be allowed to join only on production of the following certificates in original:-
 - Academic Qualification Certificates.
 - Matriculation/Date of Birth Certificate.
 - Health Certificate issued by the concerned Chief Medical Officer.
 - Permanent Resident Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
 - Certificate from the concerned authorities to the effect that no loan under self employment scheme has been taken by the appointee(s).
 - Relevant category certificates (In case of candidates belonging to reserved category).
- The appointment of the above seven candidates as Sub-Inspectors(Divisional Cadre Jammu) shall further be subject to the following conditions:-
 - The appointee(s) shall give an undertaking duly attested by the First Class Magistrate in the shape of an affidavit to the effect that in case adverse report about his/her character and antecedents is received from Inspector General of Police, (CID), J&K to whom a reference shall be made by the concerned HoD, the candidate shall have no right to claim his/her appointment as Sub Inspector and his/her appointment as such shall be deemed to have been cancelled ab-initio.
 - If on verification, the certificate(s) produced by the appointee(s) are proved to be fake or forged, the appointment shall be cancelled ab-initio.
 - The salary of the appointee(s) shall not be drawn and disbursed to the appointee(s) unless the satisfactory reports in respect of (i) and (ii) above are received in his/her favour.
 - The appointee(s) shall be on probation for a period of 02 years and shall undergo and qualify the Departmental Examination (Excise & Taxation Part- I Examination) within the period of probation.
 - The inter-se-seniority of the appointee(s) shall be strictly in accordance with the merit secured by him/her as per the select list furnished by the J&K Services Selection Board.
