Sir/Ma'am,

Kindly refer Government Order(s) quoted above, regarding re-opening of schools/guidelines on COVID containment measures in JKUT, wherein detailed SOPs were mentioned to be followed for opening of schools across JKUT. It has been observed that surge of pandemic COVID-19 has wide variation among districts.

In view of above, decision regarding running of physical classes vis a vis online classes requires to be taken at district level by the Competent Authority. I am directed to convey that all the District Magistrates/Chairman DDMA's of Kashmir/Jammu Division(s) shall take a call on the continuation of academic activities i.e. physical classes or online classes in their respective jurisdiction, keeping in view the safety of the students and present trend of Pandemic COVID-19 in different districts, Chief Education Officer and other authorities will assist in taking such decisions.
